



# PASSIVE VOICE is used when something is done to the subject




#### The clouds were **blown** away by the wind.



#### The dog is taken for a walk by Mr. Brown.






## to be +V3

### **PAY ATTENTION**

#### The hunter killed the bird.



The bird was killed by the hunter.

#### THE SUBJECT AND THE OBJECT REPLACED EACH OTHER

If it is not known or not important who did the action, miss it in the sentence in Passive Voice

They built the church in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. The church was built in the 18<sup>th</sup> century by them.



If you want to change the sentence from Active into Passive, you must: A.V. The company often sends Tom abroad. 1.change the subject and the object: Tom ..... by the company. 2. Find the verb and find out its tense sends..... **Present Simple 3.**Put the verb into the formula of this tense in Passive according to the subject is sent **P.V.** Tom is often sent abroad by the company.
